From 2006 to date: Past Director Horvath is very active as an international facilitator of different training programs, during the last years he served as faculty at all levels of Leadership Training in our Association, at Emerging, Regional, Advanced Lions Leadership Institutes, Faculty Development

Institutes, Certified Instructor Program and District Governor Elect Schools both in French and English. He is also a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow.

In recognition of his services to the association he has received numerous awards, including nine District Governor's Awards, eight Certificates of Appreciation, two Membership & Extension Awards, eight International President's Certificates of Appreciation, two Leadership Awards, twelve International President's Awards and the Ambassador of Good Will Award, the highest honor bestowed by the association to its members.
